3. FEES: The regatta registration fee of \$80 per boat includes all meals for both skipper and crew. Guest meals will be \$10.00 adults and free for youth under 13. Payment by cash or check onsite at registration. Checks can be made out to INSA or Iowa Nebraska Sailing Association.

ENTRY AND ELIGIBILITY:** This regatta is open to SCIRA registered boats and SCIRA Member skippers who are in good standing with SCIRA for the current year subject to any Deed of Gift trophy restrictions. Crews need not be members of SCIRA, but the races will not count towards the award of SCIRA's Minneford Trophy unless both skipper and crew are SCIRA members.
- **5. RULES:** The regatta will be governed by: 1.1, The rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing. (RRS) 1.2 The SCIRA Rules of Conduct for Conducting National and Local Regattas (RoC) available at: https://www.snipe.org/images/2017/2018/SCIRA-2018-roc_nochampionship-final.pdf
 The US Sailing prescriptions will apply. In case of a conflict in documentation, The Sailing Instructions shall prevail.
- **6. COURSES:** The courses to be sailed are the Class approved courses for National and Local regattas, or approved variants thereof, as published in the current SCIRA Official Rulebook and SCIRA web site and will be described in the Sailing Instructions. Such courses may be modified to take into account local conditions.
- **7. NUMBER OF RACES:** One race makes the regatta. Race Committee (RC) will attempt to complete up to six races over two days. No race will be started after 12PM on the second day of the series
- **8. AWARDS**: Missouri Valley Championship, Skipper & Crew first 3 places.
- **9. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY:** Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
- **10.
